Buckingham Palace

The State Rooms of the Palace are open to visitors in August and September. There is a designated family pavilion, where children can enjoy activities, games and crafts. They also have a fantastic 'dressing up box' so the younger ones can dress up as Princes, Princesses or the Queen's guards!

Watch The Changing of the Guard

The regular hand-over of guards in the forecourt of Buckingham Palace draws thousands of visitors to watch the soldiers and listen to the music. Children will love being close up to this spectacle and seeing the legendary guards in action. Check the dates and times with the concierge.



Tower of London

The Tower of London is one of the world's most famous and spectacular fortresses. The major draws are the Crown Jewels and the history associated with the Tower's role as a prison and for public hanging.

Windsor Castle

Natural History Museum

The museum is home to life and earth science specimens comprising some 70 million items.

The museum is particularly famous for its exhibition of dinosaur skeletons and the magnificent blue whale skeleton in the main hall.

Science Museum

There is something here for everyone, including plenty of hands-on exhibits and workshops for the kids. The aviation section is particularly impressive with many forms of aircraft to see and even simulators to help you to experience them for yourself.



London Transport Museum

The London Transport Museum explores the story of London and its transport system over the last 200 years, showcasing London's most famous icons – from the red buses and black cabs to Tube trains.

There is also an 'All Aboard' play zone for children of ages 0 to 7.

Imperial War Museum

The museum houses thousands of exhibits from art to aircraft. It covers both the military and social aspects of war.

Children particularly like the interactive videos, the Blitz Experience and simulated RAF flight.



The London Dungeon

The London Dungeon is one of London's 'must-see' signature attractions – delighting audiences for almost 40 years.

The journey takes visitors through 1,000 years of the capital's past - consisting of a series of set scenes reproducing chilling aspects of medieval London using live actors and special effects.

Shakespeare's Globe Theatre

This reconstruction of Shakespeare's Globe Theatre is located just 200 yards from the original playhouse on the banks of the river Thames. Throughout the year, a fascinating guided tour of the Globe Theatre is available, including the chance to try on original costumes.

HMS Belfast

Known as London's only war ship, the HMS Belfast was saved for the nation as a unique reminder of British heritage. Climb up and down ladders to discover all 9 decks, including the Boiler and Engine Room which are far below the water line. There are scenes set up to show what life would have been like living on the ship, from the on-board dentist to the ship's kitchens.

The Golden Hinde

The Golden Hinde is an exact replica of the ship that Sir Francis Drake used to travel around the world for the first time offering the opportunity to see what life was really like aboard an Elizabethan galleon in the days of the 16th Century. The guided tour around the ship is a unique experience as the guides are dressed in Elizabethan costume.



The Cutty Sark

Venture on board and beneath one of the world's most famous ships and discover what life was like on The Cutty Sark. The last surviving tea clipper and the fastest and greatest of her time has now been raised by three metres to allow visitors to even walk underneath and get the best view of this great ship from every angle.

Gambado

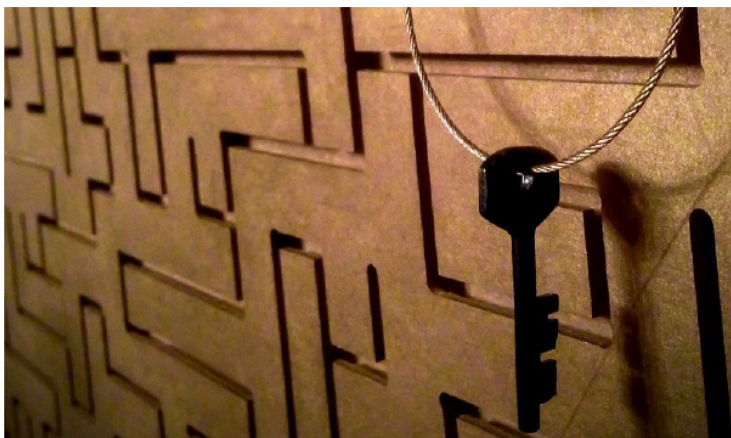

Hyde Park and Kensington Gardens

Technically two different parks, Hyde Park and Kensington Gardens are in practical and historical terms one huge, merging green expanse. Almost every kind of outdoor pursuit takes place within its 625 acres all year round.

Horse-riding, rollerblading, swimming, boating, tennis, cycling, bowling and putting are just some of the formal activities catered for.

The Diana Memorial Playground is also popular and centres round a wooden pirate ship in a sandpit which children love to climb over and explore.

Another attraction is the Peter Pan Statue which J.M. Barrie, his creator, commissioned after being so inspired by the gardens which he used to live near.



Battersea Park

This beautiful riverside park lies on the south bank of The Thames between two attractive bridges - Chelsea Bridge & Albert Bridge. It is a peaceful haven and less touristic than many of the London parks, locals love to come here to take in the views while walking their dogs.

It again has plenty for children, including a recently opened Go-Ape climbing centre, crazy golf and its own Children's zoo with monkeys.

The Royal Observatory - Greenwich

The Royal Observatory is the home of Greenwich Mean Time and the Prime Meridian of the World, making it the official starting point for each new day and year.

It is also home to London's only planetarium, the Harrison timekeepers and the UK's largest refracting telescope.

The View from the Shard

The Shard is an iconic, landmark building on the London skyline. At a height of 1,016ft (310m) it is the tallest building in Western Europe. For the best view in town, ascend to Level 72, at 244m, the highest public level of The Shard. You'll be exposed to the elements with sounds of the city around you. All tickets are dated and timed, so we advise pre-booking.
